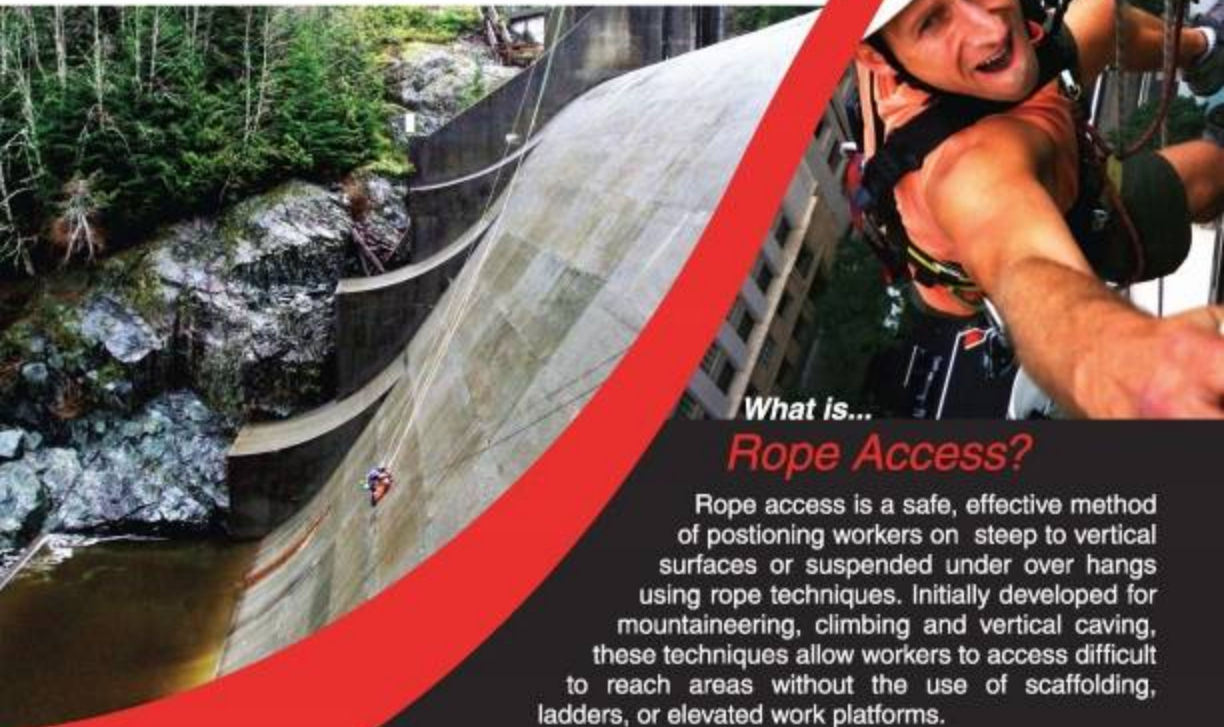


Who are...

What is...

Rope Access?

Rope access is a safe, effective method of positioning workers on steep to vertical surfaces or suspended under over hangs using rope techniques. Initially developed for mountaineering, climbing and vertical caving, these techniques allow workers to access difficult to reach areas without the use of scaffolding, ladders, or elevated work platforms.

Rope access is often used for high-rise, dam, bridge and penstock, inspections and maintenance. It is also useful for rock stabilization, maintenance on aerials, avalanche control, window cleaning and other similar at height applications. Rope access is a safe and cost effective way to position workers to access jobs using proven techniques, modern equipment, and redundant fail-safe systems.
